

INFORMATION CLAUSE (PRIVACY STATEMENT)

According to the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), we are obliged to inform you that:

2. You can contact our GDPR controller at iodo@ajp.edu.pl.
3. We collect and process your personal data due because it is necessary for the performance of a contract to which you are a party, i.e., providing lodging service or student housing (in the form of stay in Halls of Residence).

The legal basis for processing of your personal data is:

- a) taking necessary actions for the performance of the contract consisting in the provision of lodging service or student housing (article 6, para. 1, point b, GDPR);
 - b) taking necessary actions for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the Administrator, in particular, referring to submission and handling of claims (article 6, para. 1, point f, GDPR).
4. Your personal data will be stored for the duration of the period necessary for the performance of the contract to which you are a party and for handling any possible claims related to the service.
 5. Providing your personal data is voluntary but it is required to conclude a contract and service provision. The consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to provide the chosen service.
 6. In accordance with the existing legislation, you have the right to:
 - demand access to your personal data,
 - demand correction of the incorrect data,
 - demand deleting your data,
 - demand restriction of the processing of your data,
 - raise objections to the processing of your personal data and moving your data to other administrators,
 - file a complaint to President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
 7. Your personal data may be issued to public administration authorities at their demand if the relevant obligation arises in relation to their lawful activity.
 8. Your personal data will not be transferred to a third country or international organization.
